

National Lione Little League Concession Stand 2010

General Information:

- Thank you for your time and effort in supporting the league and our children by working in the concession stand.
- The concession stand is a great source of revenue for the league and allows us to make field improvements, purchase uniforms and equipment and pay umpires.
- Games should not begin until the concession stand is open.
- If you are unable to work at the concession stand on your assigned date please trade with another family on your team. Please let your team parent know about any changes.
- Please arrive at the concession stand a half hour before game time.
- Children should not be near the grill or grilling. Grill should be turned off between games.
- Children should not be left alone to run the snack bar. Parents should supervise.
- Please wear rubber gloves when handling food.
- Please keep the concession area clean and neat at all times. Use cleaning products to wipe surfaces down.
- If you are the last game of the night, please take home dirty utensils, wash and return them the next day.

Money/Cash Box/Cashing Out:

- Each game should start with \$50.00 in small bills in the cash box.
- Extra quarters and singles are in the blue money bag behind the cash box.
- Please cash out at the end of every game. Leave \$50.00 in small bills in the cash box and put the rest (the game's earnings) in the white envelopes located behind the cash box. Fill out the front of the envelope and place the earnings envelope in the large manila envelope on the bulletin board to the right of the freezer.

Afternoon/Evening Games:

- Hang up the flag
- Set up the grill if it is not out
- (We are no longer using the hot dog steamer. Cook hot dogs on the grill.)
In general, you should cook burgers as ordered. (To prevent waste.)
- If you pre-make burgers, wrap in tinfoil to keep them warm Put an orange sticker (located behind the cash box) on the tinfoil to indicate cheese burgers.
- Take condiments from the refrigerator and put out on the window ledge.
- See if there is chili in the refrigerator, if not take a new container out of the freezer and defrost it. (Chili cheeseburgers and chili hotdogs are very popular).
- Place chili in the crock pot to keep warm.
- Keep the refrigerator stocked with cold drinks. Keep chip rack stocked. Extra chips are in boxes on top of the cooler.
- At the end of the evening please:
 - **turn grill off,**
 - **wipe down all surfaces,**
 - **take down the flag**
 - **take dirty dishes home to wash,**
 - **put the grill in the snack bar and**
- **lock the door.**

Weekend Morning Games:

- Bagels - If you are working the first game of the day on Saturday or Sunday please pick up 1 ½ dozen bagels at Liz Sue bagels on High Ridge Road (they should not charge you). If they charge you, please keep the receipt and reimburse yourself from the cashbox. Leave the receipt and a note in the cashbox. Please determine who is picking up the bagels prior to the game so we don't pick up 2 sets of bagels. Slice the bagels and put cream cheese on most of them. Leave some plain and put butter on a few. Put individual bagels in baggies.
